**SNIPES FARM DAY CAMP
CAMP LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (CLP) 2018
For Youth ages 12-14**

Snipes Farm Day Camp CLP provides middle school campers with their own camp experience. This program enables young teens to develop a deeper understanding of the farm and to gain confidence and skills through camp service and leadership training activities.

Snipes Farm Day Camp provides exclusive CLP group time Monday-Wednesday that includes:

- Engaging, challenging, and fun environmental and farm education activities and projects
- Monday and Tuesday team building and leadership training activities
- A weekly adventure exploring a local park, museum, or recreation area.
- One day-a-week lunch making together. They will create the menu, harvest fresh ingredients and prepare the recipes.
- Preparing and training to lead simple activities (songs, cheers, games or a craft activity) or to share a final project with the camp community.
- The opportunity for participants to set goals and be supported to achieve them.
- Designated staff assigned to supervise, coordinate, and instruct them.

CLP Service Duties will include:

- Helping with daily camp chores
- Helping with recess, free-time activities and creek time
- Helping younger campers with art and science activities or games on Thursdays and Fridays

CLP Camp participants are required to:

- Be enthusiastic helpers to camp directors, instructors, and counselors during chore times, circle times and free-times.
- Be willing and caring mentors to younger campers by modeling SFDC guidelines and helping to build community.

COST: \$320 (same cost as attending campers) per week
